Teotihuacan is located some 50 km north-east of Mexico City (formerly Tenochtitlan). Although much of its history is still unveiled, Teotihuacan was highly perceived as a holy location. This city was a sort of a trade and commerce location, and many pre-Hispanic nations did their commercial exchange in it. Built between the 1st and 7th centuries A.D., Teotihuacan is characterized by the vast size of its monuments – in particular, the Temple of Quetzalcoatl and the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon. As one of the most potent cultural and commercial centers in Mesoamerica, this civilization extended its cultural and artistic

influence throughout the region. It might have been one of the largest ancient cities in Mesoamerica, with at least 25,000 inhabitants. After The tour also includes **Basilica de Guadalupe** Catholic shrine where they worship Guadalupe Virgin, symbol of the religious syncretism.
